

Summer is here, and people are getting outside. Please be mindful that if there is no sidewalk, **walk facing traffic and as far from traffic as possible**. Cross streets at crosswalks or intersections. Look for cars in all directions. If a crosswalk or intersection is not available, locate a well-lit area where you have the best view of traffic. When bicycling remember to wear equipment to protect you and make you more visible to others, like a bike helmet, bright clothing (during the day), reflective gear, and a white front light and red rear light and reflectors on your bike (at night, or when visibility is poor).
