Visit the State of Illinois Online Voter Application Portal at <https://ova.elections.il.gov/>

**General Primary is Tuesday, June 28th for more election information visit <https://www.elections.il.gov>**

The registration period for the online voter registration system will close at 11:59 PM on 06/12/2022 and will reopen on 06/30/2022

- You must be a United States Citizen.
- You must be at least 17 years old on or before the date of the Primary Election and turn 18 on or before the date of the General or Consolidated Election.
- You must live in your election precinct at least 30 days prior to Election Day.
- You must not be serving a sentence of confinement in any penal institution as a result of a conviction.
- You may not claim the right to vote anywhere else.
