COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

The Community Development Committee Meeting was called to order at 5:30 P.M. with Trustee Ackerman in person at the Village Hall. The meeting was recorded to be made available to the public complying with the Governor's Executive Orders.

ROLL CALL: ACKERMAN in person, MCKINNON- present remotely, PEARSON- absent.

There was no conflict of interest noted.

There was no request for public comment.

Trustee McKinnon made the motion to approve the minutes of March 30, 2023, seconded by Trustee Ackerman. Motion carried on the roll call vote of those present.

DISCUSSION: Community Development Past Projects and Future Project Planning

Trustee Ackerman informed the committee that he had attended an ILPA (Illinois Parks and Recreation Association) grant seminar for funding park improvements. The time frame to submit for a grant was May. Trustee McKinnon suggested having a Committee of the Whole meeting to get support for the park improvement, and for large project expenditures. Trustee Ackerman will contact the members of the Park Hills Church who once expressed interest in the park projects.

There was discussion regarding the process of zoning matters in relationship to Community Development, and when it is appropriate for them to come to the committee prior to going to the Regular Board meeting for action. Attorney Gaziano suggested a combined committee meeting with zoning for matters such as pre-annexation.
